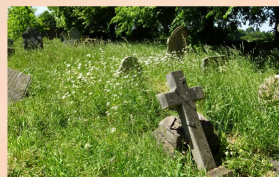

that we may truly worship you,
Father, Son and Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.
